Good luck everyone involved - Remember to put your padded shorts onit's a long way to Guernsey! ☺

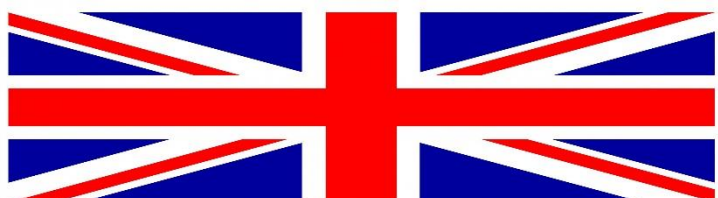
MAKING PLANS...
