Georgeham Primary School Uniform Policy

We believe that having a uniform helps create a sense of identity and encourages self-respect. Smartly dressed young people give a good impression of themselves and the school. We rely on the support of parents in ensuring that our young people come to school dressed appropriately, and presented smartly.

The school has guidelines on dress and all pupils will be expected to wear the full school uniform. The wearing of our distinctive uniform gives pupils a sense of 'belonging', helps foster pride in the school and stops pupils coming in unsuitable clothes or children comparing themselves with others.

Aims

Our policy is based on the belief that a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Engenders a feeling of belonging
- Practical and distinctive
- Identifies the children with the school
- Makes children feel equal to one another in terms of appearance
- Reflects the sense both of community and of diversity that the school takes pride in
- Regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents

School Uniform

Children are expected to wear:

- Black/Grey trousers or black shorts or skirt or pinafore dress (jeans and cords are not allowed)
- plain polo shirt or white formal shirt or blouse
- Summer gingham dress (red and white)
- Black leggings under the skirt where appropriate
- Black or white socks or black or grey tights with skirts
- White, black, brown or red hijab where appropriate
- School sweatshirt or cardigan, in red, this can be plain or with the school logo

PE Days

All children must wear a PE kit during PE and sporting activities for safety reasons

During PE days, children are expected to come to school wearing:

- plain black tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts
- plain white or red t-shirt
- plain jumper/hoody for colder PE sessions

Parents are asked to provide:

- Sensible black shoes
- Suitable footwear for PE (trainers or daps)
- A warm coat for travelling to and from school

Jewellery is not allowed, except for one pair of ear studs. Earring hoops, rings, nail varnish and makeup are not allowed.
